

**MidPenn Legal Services fights for low-income families and domestic violence survivors, delivering free legal aid that transforms crisis into stability.**

The Pennsylvania Legal Aid Network provides 51.9% of our funding from various sources including, Interest on Lawyer Trust Accounts, state and federal Title XX, filing fee add-ons, and the Disability Advocacy Project. The Legal Services Corporation provides 30.1% of our funds.

Additional support comes from United Ways, bar associations, local groups, private foundations, individuals, state and local government contracts.

MidPenn Legal Services is a nonprofit, public interest law firm serving 18 counties in Central Pennsylvania.

We provide free civil legal aid to help low-income families and survivors of domestic violence solve problems that impact their personal safety, family stability and economic security.
